Cllr Heaver and Keane attended the 6th form proposed closure meeting at Penketh High School

the main reason behind this, 80 students attending the 6th form well below the 130 required for

it to be viable, however transport to other colleges discussed, and students said to be voting

with their feet and no parental support with only one complaint to Cllr Keane being received.

Graffiti cleaned from Greystone Recreational Ground recently at the cost of £180.

Warrington Borough Council advised they had attended a property in Grange Drive that had

been reported to be in poor repair; advice was offered but not taken by the owner. Discussion

was held regarding this matter.
