C2192 COMMUNITY POLICING REPORT

Pcso D Samuel sent a report, Clerk read as follows

Following last month's busy report packed with incidents. I'm pleased to state this month has been very, very quiet in Penketh. This was great news for Carl and I especially since this includes both the Halloween and Bonfire periods. The only thing of note to report to the members is the parking issues we are currently addressing on Farnworth Road near to the neat Over 55's apartments. We have issued tickets previously and I will be calling in this week to speak with new residents to ask them not so obstruct the path with their vehicles. No major issues on Bonfire night and a very successful display at Penketh Primary School. There one single report made in relation to Withenshaw Park which was report of a fire on the park. It was attended by a colleague who was unable to find any evidence of this. Other than that we have nothing to report, however this isn't the case elsewhere in Warrington as Chapelford has been particularly busy.

Concern was raised by Cllr King that the whole Police building was to be vacated after Christmas, and lease maybe available, or could be left empty, PSCO's now travel by public transport to their place of duty if no car available, however Cllr K Brennan advised in Commissioner's meeting that Chief Inspector stating that Police were not spending alot of time on public transport, discussion held.

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Resolved: Clerk to confirm that reports and attendance of Police to remain and not deteriate and hope contact not lost due to this, and to praise work/contact Penketh Parish Council has had.

Cllr Heaver advised that 3.49 people used the service per journey, this information was freely available, service was not profitable, smaller buses have been sold, so a re-route was not possible, Cllr L Dirir added this service was threaten a few years ago and this service was socially needed. Cllr Keane to investigate when buses were sold

Resolved: Services as a whole and alternative solution to be sought by three Ward and Borough Councillors and a meeting with Maureen Banner at Warrington Borough Transport to be held.

Cllr Keane asked on the background discussion, status, process and best practices for the Community Interest group regarding the playgrounds within Penketh. A discussion was held regarding visibility on upkeep, ongoing costs, funding, and inclusion of wider community/residents. This was not to be a decision group just ideas. Clerk has collated some prices already.

Resolved: Penketh Parish Council to hold a special Community Consultation meeting regarding the play equipment in Penketh, to advertise on webpage and Penketh Events Committee/Cllr King to insert on Project Christmas leaflet, meeting to be held at Youth Centre on 6th February 2016.
