On Friday 4th November 2016, I visited Moore Nature Reserve and spoke with rangers in regards to ongoing issues. Email address passed and I have been patrolling the area throughout November. Visited the nature reserve on the 6th November 2016 no issues.

On Friday 11th November 2016, I attended St Mary's Cemetery and assisted with the litter pick and cleaning up of the Cemetery ready for remembrance Sunday. I worked with organisers Trudy Wood of Friends of St Mary's Cemetery.

Also on the 11th November I took out the community speed gun and gunned on Stocks Lane, Warrington Road and Heath Road.

On Saturday 12th November 2016 I attended Penketh Community Primary's Organised. I patrolled the school and surrounding roads liaising with the school

for cars which were parked blocking pavements or too close to the corner on Meeting Lane to be moved.

Shop Watch Scheme has also been update this month. There does not seem to be as many shoplifting in the area since the scheme started. Shop Watch has identified one male this month who allegedly committed a theft from the Co Operative Supermarket, Warrington Road.

I have continued to patrol the area around Penketh South Primary School and St Vincent's. Myself and my colleague Jack CHISNELL has issued one fixed penalty notice to a vehicle which was blocking the pavement on Ditchfield Road. On monitoring the area I have not witnessed Chapel Road becoming blocked. I have however given one Fixed penalty notice for blocking on the pavement on Chapel Road.

Throughout November I have supported Gill CUMERFORD on the school Crossing Warrington Road and have been sending letters home to people who are not stopping when she is signalling. I am going to continue to support the crossing throughout December.

On Saturday 26th November 2016 I did an area walk with local Councillor and Police and Crime Commissioner David Keane. We also looked and discussed the option of setting up and Community hub and Penketh Pool and Community Centre.
