C2779 APOLOGIES

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr L Ashton.

C2780 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST OF MEMBERS

Members were reminded of their responsibility to declare any personal or prejudicial interest that they may have had in any item of business on the agenda no later than when the item was reached.

C2781 COMMUNITY POLICING REPORT

PCSO Heaps was in attendance, issue raised about a caravan on Station Road, he was liaising with Warrington Borough Council and Railtrack for its removal. Ongoing investigations into recent burglaries. Penketh Resident Association along with Psco Heaps help, are trying to set up a Neighbourhood Watch scheme, suggestion made for possible promotion at Christmas Market, with a dedicated single point of contact required for scheme. Assault and shop lifting at Wynsors. Concerns over recent accident along Warrington Road/Heath Road junction, discussion held on ongoing concerns raised at positioning of crossing and dangers associated, especially with speed allocated to A562, Warrington Borough Council are looking at extending the central reservation and it was advised the planters give perception of the road being slower than itis. It was noted a vehicle count had been completed, awaiting results. Also

speed issues on Stocks Lane, and traffic issues around new site on corner Crown and Cushion, further discussion held.

C2782 ISSUES RAISED BY MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC

A resident asked for update on survey from Health Centre and Doctors on Honiton Way,

Resolved: Cllr Dirir to pass details to Clerk, to write to NHS.

A resident raised concerns on three areas of overgrown hedges, one appropriate to Penketh Parish Council, it was highlighted that the Head of Public Highways had not yet been replaced, it was believed one area had had some work done. It was suggested for Community

Payback team to possibly complete work on Parish land.

Resolved: Clerk to enquire about appointment at Right of way department and to contact

Community payback team.

A resident enquired about recent amendment on Penketh Parish website of AGAR section 2 Clerk explained changes with Precept paid to Parish and allocation of Council Support Tax and External Auditor advised that a split was required, no change to overall figures.

A resident queried why two bus journeys had different fares, it was explained different owners charge different prices, Parish has no say on this, his frustration was understandable, and feedback would be given, an update was asked on recent circular route offer and loss of services in Penketh. Negotiations had been ongoing and were being looked at in January due to Election in December as not wanted to be seen as electioneering A further discussion was held on frequency, utilising high school buses, circular routes, empty buses and frequency.

A resident passed lighting details and contact for 14th December Carol Concert to Cllr Fellows with the understanding any damage Penketh Parish Council would be liable with the offer free to use them.
