# C2532 ISSUES RAISED BY MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC.

Residents in attendance enquired about speeding along A562 Warrington Road and asked about permanent Speed equipment, Clerk advised this item was on agenda. Road Safety Officer at school crossing advised cars were weaving along the road to get through the traffic quicker and sometimes not stopping for her, this has become worse since the new Gateway Bridge had opened. Cllr L Dirir responded by reminding everyone the Council were opposed to the tolls and had advised this would be an issue, she asked for the traffic counts to be made public before the bridge and now.

Resident had photographic evidence that HGV were using Stocks Lane as a cut through although signs to advise not to use said road.

A resident complained about the alleyway between Maple Crescent onto Warrington Road where units appear to have fly tipping and brambles encroaching onto pathway.
