C2351 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Cllr L Dirir proposed that the minutes of the Full Council meeting held on November12th 2016 be approved. Seconded by Cllr A Dirir.

C2352 MATTERS ARISING

Meeting to be set up for New Year regarding highway issues around the bottom of Heath Road and Warrington Road junction. Cllr D Keane advised a letter had been delivered from Ward Councilors to residents in the Farnworth Road area to update them on the planned extra six parking spaces for Penketh Court and that there was to be Warrington Borough Council consultation on double yellow lines in the area. Cllr Heaver thanked him for this and the update. Cllr D Keane was upset that it had taken since last December for this action and that residents were blaming Penketh Parish Councillors for lack of assistance in this problem and not Highways department at Warrington Borough Council, Cllr D Keane had advised residents that Penketh Parish Council did not have any powers to resolve this situation but could provide

communication tools and offer support to them. Cllr A Dirir agreed this was a problematic area due to many demographic changes and less parking available to more cars to the area. Cllr D Keane advised the land at old Crown and Cushion car park was still for sale and felt the purchase of it could be a solution to the problems of parking, three solutions were made known, leave it empty, if built on parking would become worse, or own it and allow parking. Cllr Heaver and Cllr A Dirir both expressed they thought the purchase of it for parking was a great solution. A discussion was held on the land and way forward, it was agreed for Cllr D Keane to pursue and arrange a meeting with Steven Broomhead in the New Year to discuss.

2016/29241 Cllr L Dirir had looked at details on this application and a discussion was held on the background and especially the closing of the site, two large ash lagoons would be required to be put right as they are fill with water from the Power Station and when it closes this source would not be there, Cllr D Keane advised that the Penketh Parish Council needed to be vigilant and watch for consultation plans and what lagoon management there would be, Cllr L Dirir advised remedial work would not be acceptable and they would need to be totally cleansed.

Resolved; Clerk to ask to set up a for a meeting with SSE station Manager, Penketh Parish and Ward Councillors in view of planning application and long term plans for the site.

Cllr L Dirir advised a resident had attended surgery to discuss Friends Lane stable with a view to a planning application, they has been advised by Michael Davies at Planning to approach Penketh Parish Council before submitting plans. Cllr L Dirir advised resident no comment could be made at this stage as no plans had been submitted and that they went before the Full Council not just one person , however did advise feelings of Penketh Parish Council if encroaching in greenbelt land, that they normally were not in favour of this.
