Since 2018 when a member of the public requested that better lighting was installed to provide a safer environment for the pool and hall users, a request which was never followed up.

This is to increase the safety and security of patrons of the centre during dark evenings and better protect the building whilst reducing energy usage and costs by replacing the old Halogen with more economic equipment.

Motion; to approve the decision that the council will seek and resolve the issue of poor external lighting for the exterior of Council Premises with the repurpose of existing LED Lighting and installing a photo cell which will further improve efficiency and reduce our carbon footprint.

12.2 Annual PAT Testing

As a statutory legal requirement within our Health and Safety Policy and within the Councils insurance policy documentation we must complete an annual test of all electrical appliances on the premises.

Motion; This Council authorises the completion of its annual PAT testing requirements to be carried out by the resident electrician. To authorise works to be carried out and for the payment of £?? to be approved.

12.3 Community Defibrillator

This is to replace the existing inhouse equipment which is currently only accessible at times when the centre is open and presently not providing for the general public 24 hours a day. The Council already have a responsibility to maintain the first Public Access AED (located on Penketh library wall) which is now in need of a replacement battery this motion is to include the procurement of a replacement battery also.

Motion; That this council will approve the spend of up to £2.5K including professional installation costs of an external Defibrillator on the Parish Council Community property wall.

13 Parish Council Website – Cllr Potts

Council to review and approve spend for replacement website provider to allow the Clerk great autonomy over updating the site and providing clear and efficient Agendas/Minutes/Audit/Policy documentation as well as allow training and support if/when required.

14 Solar Energy Company – Cllr Fellows

Penketh Parish Council have been a keen supporter of green energy and have benefited from the installation of Solar Panels for the past few years. However the Council as a collective have never been offered access to these reports. It has been previously mentioned that Cllr Heaver received reports for the energy created and information of financial revenue generated sent to a personal email. As this information is the property of PPC and not an individual councillor on a personal email address this motion is to address the matter of GDPR, openness and transparency, and to assist in the budget information of the finance and Business Committees.

Motion; This council politely requests Cllr Heaver, as an assumed named contact with the solar energy company, relinquish his name as account holder, updating this information by redirecting correspondence to the proper officer of the council and forward on any historic emails prior to deleting from his personal account. This task is to be completed by December 31st 2021.
